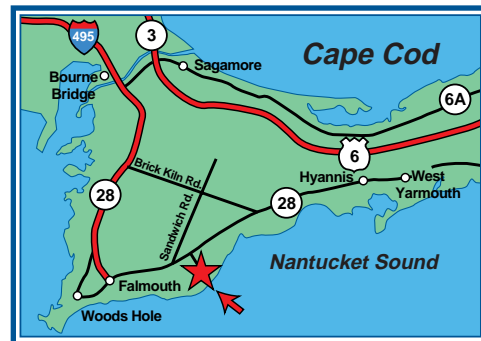

How to Find CapeWind From the Bourne Bridge:

- Cross the Bourne Bridge, staying on Rte. 28 South to Falmouth.
- Get off at the Brick Kiln Rd. exit. At the bottom of the exit ramp, turn left at the stop sign.
- Take a right at the 2nd traffic light on to Sandwich Rd. to Rte. 28.
- Take a left on Rte. 28, go 1/4 mile to the traffic light.
- Take a right on to Maravista Ave. Extension. The CapeWind is about 200 yards on the left.

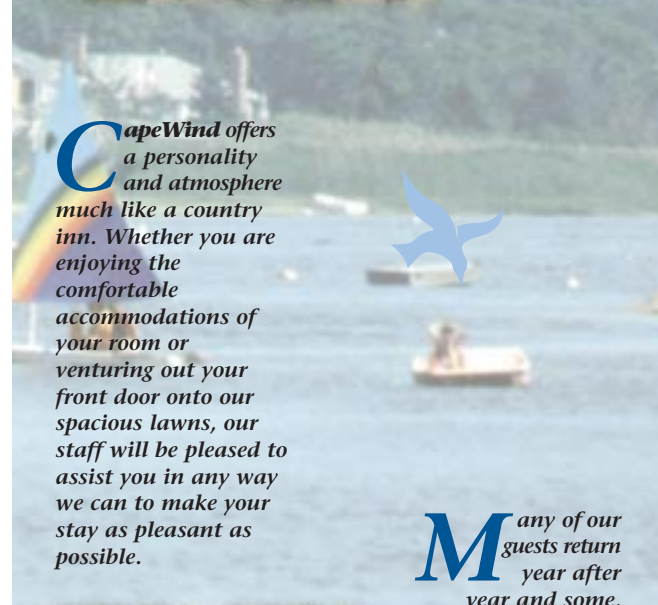
